

Community Resilience Team

Reports to: The Town Council

The Resilience Team shall report to the Town Council. It has no executive authority and shall present regular updates on the production of the Community Resilience Plan.

The Resilience Team:

- Will have the ability to co-opt non-members if required
- Shall meet as and when required – recommended bi-annually
- Develop and implement a Resilience Plan for the Town
- Keep under review the safety of the community within the Town and make recommendations to the Town Council on any matter arising from this
- Liaise with the emergency services as part of the Resilience Plan
- Liaise with local planning and highways if necessary during, or as a follow up, to an emergency affecting the Town
- Liaise with the City Council, County Council, NHS bodies, Environment Agency and other public bodies during and following the emergency
- Review process of assistance given during the emergency and explore any factors which might be modified in the future including possible prevention of emergencies
- Liaise with Chelmsford City Council Community Resilience Officer regularly for joint party updates
- Once created, review and update Community Resilience Plan as needed, at least annually

Agendas and notes for the Resilience Team will be provided to all Town Councillors.
